Qualifications

- Grade Point Average of **2.0 or higher**
- Must show a financial "gap" in order to apply. (Apply all available aid and still have a remaining balance)

Requirements

- Completed Application submitted by May 1, 2023
- Essay-200-300 words
 - What do you want to be true for yourself four years from now?
 - Consider sharing your dreams for life personally, academically, and professionally.

Requirements for the winner

- Submission of grades after semester 1 and 2 (2.5 GPA needed for renewal)
- A personal statement about how the scholarship impacted you as a student, your experience, organizations and clubs that you were able to join or volunteer for, etc.
- A thank you note to the donors.
