Qualifications

- DECA High senior graduating in the Class of 2023
- Grade Point Average of **2.0 or higher**
- Must show a financial "gap" in order to apply. (Apply all available aid and still have a remaining balance)

Requirements

- Completed Application submitted by May 1, 2023
- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Updated Resume including, but not limited to work and volunteer experiences
- Essay- Four Parts- no word minimums or maximums
 - Part 1:Tell us about yourself. What makes you a worthy candidate for this scholarship?
 - o Part 2: What do you aspire to achieve in your future?
 - Part 3: Share an experience that has impacted your life or perspective
 - o Part 4: Once you attain success, in what ways would you like to 'give back' or 'pay it forward'?

Requirements for the winner

- Submission of grades after semester 1 and 2.
- A personal statement about how the scholarship impacted you as a student, your experience, organizations and clubs that you were able to join or volunteer for, etc.
- A thank you note to the donors.
